GET READY TO EXPAND YOUR LINGUISTIC ABILITIES AND PROFOUNDLY UNDERSTAND AND CONNECT WITH EVERY NUANCE OF HUMAN INTERACTION.

"MAKING SENSE OF ASSESSMENTS AND NORMING DATA"

WORKSHOP INTRODUCTION:

THIS WORKSHOP OFFERS AN IN-DEPTH LOOK AT THE MAJOR ASSESSMENTS USED TO MEASURE INTERPRETER PERFORMANCE, GAUGE WHETHER OR NOT A CANDIDATE CAN RECEIVE A CERTIFICATION, AND HOW DATA IS USED METRICALLY DOCUMENT PERFORMANCE. SINCE NO ONE ASSESSMENT IS ALIKE, IT IS IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND THEIR SIMILARITIES, DIFFERENCES, AND LEVEL OF MASTERY EACH OFFER. EQUALLY, IT IS IMPORTANT TO UNDERSTAND THE AIMS OF EACH METRIC, AND HOW A LICENSE GRANTING BODY CAN USE THESE METRICS TO MAKE INFORMED AND EDUCATED DECISIONS RELATED TO LICENSURE RECOGNITION
